**Hypothermia in Newborn**

The incidence of moderate hypothermia (32 – 36 ° C) in the newborn babies admitted to neonatal intensive care following caesarian section, including the very low birth weight and extremely low birth weight babies has decreased from 42 % to 15 % since January 2006. Through careful interventions like increasing operating room temperature, pre-warming baby towels, educating health care personnel, use of transport incubator and by the use of cling wrap to prevent heat loss, we are now able to reduce the incidence of hypothermia. The incidence of babies with temperature less than 35 °C has remained 0% since the beginning of interventions. On going measures are continued to further sustain the results between 0-10 percent.
